ORDER SEALING GUARDIAN AD LITEM REPORT TO COURT

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on the Guardian Ad Litem's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records pursuant to Fla. Fam. L. R. P. 12.400 and Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(e). The Court, having considered the motion and being otherwise advised in the premises, finds:

1. The Court has authority to seal the Guardian Ad Litem Report to the Court.
2. This is a family law case.
3. The information contained in the Guardian Ad Litem Report to the Court should be sealed to avoid substantial injury to third parties, to wit, the minor children who are the subject of this action.
4. The minor children's names should remain confidential, and the children should be referred to as THR and ACR.
5. The progress docket and other records generated to document activity in the case are not determined to be confidential.
6. All information contained in the Guardian Ad Litem Report to the Court is confidential.
7. The only persons permitted to view the confidential information are the parties, their counsel of record, and the Guardian Ad Litem in this case.


8. The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth herein, and no less restrictive means are available to protect those interests.

Based on the foregoing findings of fact, it is hereby **ADJUDGED** as follows:

A. The Clerk of Court is directed to seal the Guardian Ad Litem Report to the Court in this matter.

B. The Clerk of Court is directed to publish this Order in accordance with Fla. R. Jud. Admin. 2.420(e)(4).


