**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF
COURT RECORDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULE OF JUDICIAL
ADMINISTRATION 2.420(c)(9)**

THIS MATTER is before the Court on a Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records filed by Plaintiff, FLETCHER PLUMBING, INC , pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) for an order sealing the following information relative to this civil action case

That particular information located within the Notice of Confidential Information Within Court Filing dated February 10, 2021, at Page 7 through 12

Counsel for Marion County Clerk of Court has no objection to the relief sought Service of process of the Summons on Eddie Bryant, Jr , and Florida Department Of Revenue has not been perfected as of the date of this Order

Having considered the arguments of the parties, legal authority, and otherwise being fully advised, the Court **GRANTS** the motion as follows

1 Confidentiality of the Release and Mediated Settlement Agreement is required with Rule of Judicial Administration 2 420(c)(9) to protect the following interests
Both documents sought to be sealed are confidential settlement documents containing the settlement amount reached by the parties

2 The Court further finds that no less restrictive measure available to protect these interests and that the degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered herein is no broader than necessary to protect these interests

WHEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** that

In accordance with Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2 420 and the Standards for Access to Electronic Court Records and Access Security Matrix, the Clerk of the Circuit Court is hereby directed to maintain as confidential the following materials related to this matter

1 The information located within the Notice of Confidential Information Within Court Filing dated February 10, 2021, at Page 7 through 12


It is further **ORDERED** that any materials sealed pursuant to this Order shall be conditionally disclosed upon the entry of a further order by this Court finding that such opening is necessary for purposes of judicial or governmental accountability or First Amendment rights

It is further **ORDERED** that, within 10 days of the date of this Order, the Clerk shall post a copy of this Order on the bulletin board of the Marion County Courthouse and the Clerk's website for a period of 30 days to provide public notice

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby authorized to unseal any materials sealed pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files, or

transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal The materials shall be resealed immediately upon completion of the filing
